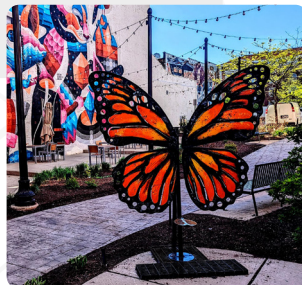
We exist to **grow a stronger Jackson County** by building partnerships, expanding opportunity, and investing in people who call Jackson County home.

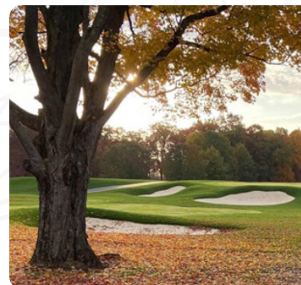
